Wage Summary

RATES OF PAY AS AT 1 JULY 2017

The Fair Work Commission released its minimum wage decision on 12 June 2017. The decision, **effective from the first full pay period on or after 1 July 2017** sees the modern award rates increased by <u>3.3%</u>.

This increase flows on to junior employees, employees to whom training arrangements apply and employees with a disability.

Who does this wage summary apply to?

The attached wage summary applies to employers that are operating under the *Food, Beverage and Tobacco Manufacturing Award 2010.* This award covers businesses engaged in preparing, cooking, baking, blending, brewing, fermenting, preserving, filleting, gutting, freezing, refrigerating, decorating, washing, grading, processing, distilling, manufacturing and milling of food, beverage and tobacco products, including stock feed and pet food, and ancillary activities such as:

- (a) the receipt, storing and handling of ingredients and raw materials to make food, beverage and tobacco products, including stock feed and pet food;
- (b) the bottling, canning, packaging, labelling, palletising, storing, preparing for sale, packing and despatching of food, beverage and tobacco products, including stock feed and pet food; and
- (c) the cleaning and sanitising of tools, equipment and machinery used to produce food, beverage and tobacco products, including stock feed and pet food.

Please note that businesses operating under workplace agreements (such as AWAs, ITEAs, certified agreements, or enterprise agreements) are not bound by this wage summary and instead should refer to the NRA Agreement Wage Summary to determine the minimum base hourly rates of pay that apply.

Fair Work Ombudsman's Guidelines

The NRA has calculated the figures in this wage summary by rounding to 2 decimal places throughout the calculation process. Where there are discrepancies in rounding from any other pay guide issued by any other agency or entity, we are advised by the Fair Work Ombudsman that these discrepancies are within acceptable limits.
